

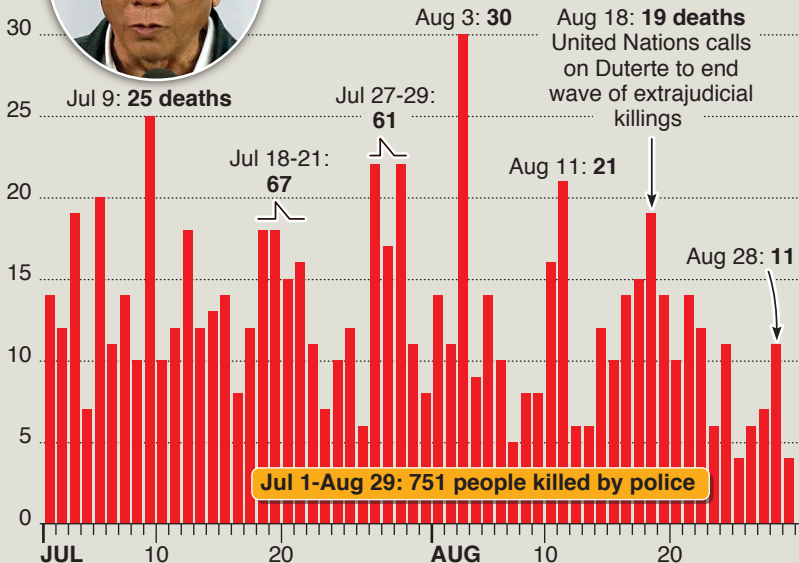
Philippines anti-drug crackdown

More than 750 people have been killed in police anti-narcotics operations since July 1 – the day after President Rodrigo Duterte came to power – while a further 1,200 deaths are being investigated as vigilante killings
