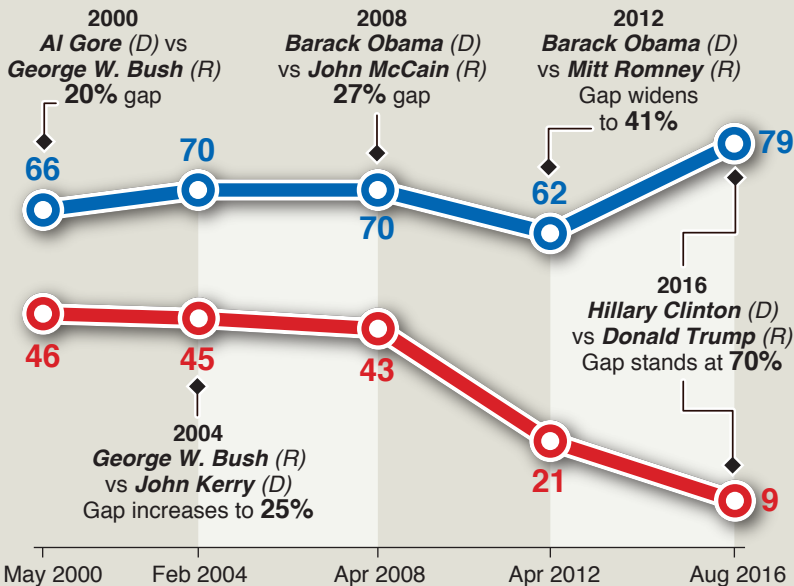


Conflicting U.S. feelings on gun control

The U.S. divide over gun ownership has widened during the presidential race with 79% of Democrats believing it is more important to control gun ownership than protect gun rights, compared to just 9% of Republicans
