

iPhone 7 rumour roundup

Highly detailed supply chain leaks give an insight into the iPhone 7's improved features, ahead of its launch on Wednesday, September 7

Rear camera flash: Upgraded with four LEDs (two cool and two warm) and new ambient light sensor for better image quality

Earpiece: Doubles as loudspeaker, providing enough separation to allow for stereo sound when device is held in landscape orientation

Screen: Better wide colour technology adopted from iPad Pro

Water resistance: Improved IPX7 waterproofing allows device to survive splashes, showering, and even brief dips in water up to one metre deep

Dual-lens rear camera: Exclusive to *iPhone 7 Plus*. Two 12MP lenses – one wide-angle, other telephoto

New A10 processor and improved storage: 32GB, 128GB, and 256GB on both iPhone 7* and iPhone 7 Plus

No headphone jack: Ships with Lightning EarPods and regular earphone adapter. Removal of jack allows for upgraded speaker and improved *Force Touch* sensor

Home button: Pressure-sensitive, with no click, to benefit water resistance. Haptic motor mimics clicking sensation when button is pressed
