1903: British suffragette Emmeline Pankhurst formed an organisation to fight for votes for women

1911: China's Xinhai Revolution began. It overthrew China's 4,000-year-old Qing Dynasty and established the Republic of China

1995: A one-day strike by five million public sector workers in France brought the country to a standstill
