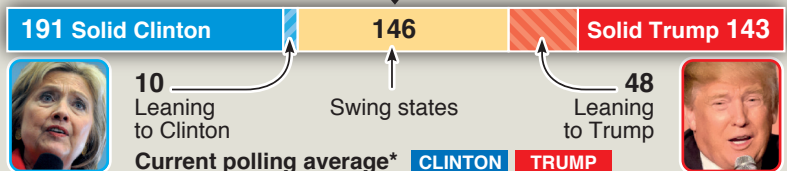


# Must-win U.S. battleground states

Hillary Clinton and Donald Trump have poll differences of 1.4% or less in five of 11 swing states in the U.S. presidential election. Five states are also crucial, with 98 of 146 Electoral College votes up for grabs

270 of 538 Electoral College votes needed to win presidency



**1 Florida:** 29 electoral votes.  
2012: **Barack Obama** beat **Mitt Romney** by just 0.9%

44.8% 44.0% 0.8% difference

**2 Pennsylvania:** 20 electoral votes.  
Voted Democrat in last four elections.  
2012: Obama won state by 5.2%

47.2% 39.0%

**Nevada:** 6 electoral votes

43.8% 42.4% 1.4%

**Colorado:** 9 electoral votes

46.0% 35.0%

**Iowa:** 6 electoral votes

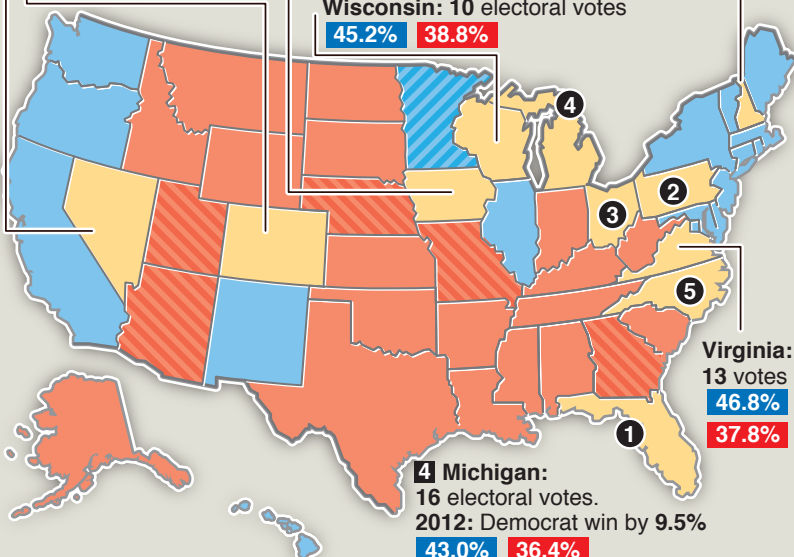

2012: Democrat win by 2.98%
