▲ **Pu-Yi, five-year-old emperor of China, granted a new constitution that ended three centuries of Manchu domination and paved the way for a new republic**

1961: The Soviet Union tested the hydrogen bomb Tsar Bomba, the largest explosive device ever detonated

1974: Muhammad Ali regained the world heavyweight boxing title by knocking out George Foreman

1988: Sun Myung Moon held a mass wedding of over 6,500 couples in Seoul

2007: Six French aid workers and three journalists were charged with child abduction in Chad after trying to fly 103 orphans to Europe
