▲ **British singer-songwriter Adele's comeback album, 25, sold 3.38 million copies in the U.S., the first album to exceed the 3 million mark in its first week on sale**

1884: A patent was issued for evaporated milk, an unsweetened milk with up to 75% less water

1952: The world's longest running show, Agatha Christie's mystery *The Mousetrap*, opened in London

1997: The Tokyo City Bank became the fourth Japanese finance house to close since the start of the month
