▲ **Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon entered the tomb of the Egyptian pharaoh Tutankhamun, the first men to do so since it was sealed in 1337BC**

1966: The world's first tidal power station was opened in France at the Rance estuary in Brittany

1979: The International Olympic Committee voted to re-admit China after an absence of 21 years

2001: A U.S. firm claimed to have cloned the first human embryo for use in medical research

2008: A series of terror attacks in Mumbai, India's financial capital, killed 173 people
