▲ **Turkey agreed to help stem the flow of migrants to Europe in return for cash and visas from the European Union, and renewal of talks on joining the EU**

1516: Italian Renaissance painter Giovanni Bellini, who made Venice a centre of art to rival Florence, died

1972: Atari announced the release of Pong, the first commercially successful video game

1996: The War Crimes Tribunal in The Hague passed its first sentence since WWII, jailing a Bosnian Serb soldier for his part in the Srebrenica massacre

2012: The UN recognised Palestine as a non-member state
