

President Trump – world's new uncertainty

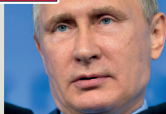
World leaders have offered to work with U.S. President-elect Donald Trump, but have expressed anxiety over his campaign threats



CHINA

Trump threatens 45% tariff on Chinese imports

President Xi Jinping “look forward to working with you to uphold the principles of non-conflict, non-confrontation, mutual respect and win-win cooperation”



RUSSIA

U.S.-Russia ties strained over conflicts in Syria and Ukraine

President Vladimir Putin “build constructive dialogue between Moscow and Washington, based on principles of equality, mutual respect”



IRAN

Trump opposes nuclear accord between Tehran and world powers that led to easing of sanctions

Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei Has pledged to “set fire” to nuclear deal if West violates it



GERMANY

Trump describes government as “insane” for allowing migrants into country

Chancellor Angela Merkel We “share values of democracy, freedom, respecting the rule of law, people’s dignity”



ISRAEL

Trump: Two-state solution is not way to end Israel-Palestinian conflict

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu “unique bond” between our two countries “will be strengthened”



MEXICO

Trump threatens to scrap NAFTA trade deal and build wall on southern border

President Enrique Peña Nieto welcomed Trump’s victory speech pledge to seek “common ground”



SOUTH KOREA

Trump suggests withdrawing U.S. forces from South Korea: “We get paid peanuts”

President Park Geun-hye paid \$867 million – 40% of costs of deploying some 28,500 U.S. troops in 2014

Presidential election less than six months away

Marine Le Pen, National Front leader, “great movement across the world” – Trump’s election victory heralds dawn of new world order
