▲ **Arkansas teacher Hattie Ophelia Caraway became the first woman elected to the U.S. Senate. She was re-elected in 1938 and finally left office in 1945**

1875: Kwang-su, the penultimate Emperor of China, ascended the throne when only four years old

1957: Elvis Presley recorded *All Shook Up*. It topped the U.S. pop chart for eight weeks

1967: Dr James Bedford became the first person to be cryopreserved after death, with the hope of future resuscitation

1992: Russia and Ukraine agreed to divide the Black Sea fleet
