

Suzuki's retro-styled mini-SUV

The all-new Suzuki Ignis is the marque's answer to the crossover SUV boom. The entry-level SZ3 model is available in 11 colours and equipped with six airbags, air conditioning, and Bluetooth connectivity

Cargo capacity: 227 litres, 514 litres with seats folded down

Dualjet engine: 1.2-litre four-cylinder. Top spec SZ5 model adds 48-volt SHVS "mild hybrid" system. Power: 90PS, torque: 120Nm, CO₂: 96-106g/km, 0-100km/h: 11.7 secs




Wheelbase: 2,435mm
