January 19, 1825

▲ **Thomas Kensett and Ezra Daggett were granted a U.S. patent for their process of storing food in tin cans. Food canning had begun in France and England from 1810**

1975: Arab gunmen attacked an El Al jumbo jet and seized three hostages at Orly Airport in Paris, injuring 20 people

1997: Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat visited the city of Hebron for the first time in 32 years

2003: China's historic Yuzhengong Palace was destroyed by fire

2012: Eastman Kodak, 130-year-old photographic film pioneer which invented the hand-held camera, filed for bankruptcy protection
