## Today in History

*January 25, 1997*

▲ Swiss tennis star Martina Hingis, aged only 16, captured the Australian Open title to become the youngest Grand Slam singles winner of the 20th century

**1945:** Grand Rapids, in Michigan, became the first city to add fluoride to its drinking water to reduce tooth decay

**2006:** The militant Islamic group Hamas won a surprise victory in the Palestinian parliamentary election

**2007:** The Ford Motor Company reported the biggest ever loss, of \$12.7 billion, in its 103-year history

**2013:** Violent protests erupted in Egypt on the second anniversary of its Arab Spring revolution
