▲ The teddy bear was introduced in America, named after President Theodore (Teddy) Roosevelt who had spared the life of a bear cub during a hunt

1922: The Permanent Court of International Justice, sitting in The Hague in Holland, held its first session

1992: Two Spaniards completed the first east-west balloon flight across the Atlantic from Spain to Venezuela

2007: The Hamas-led Palestinian government made way for a unity government of both Fatah and Hamas

2013: A meteor explodes over Chelyabinsk, in Siberia, injuring more than 1,000 people
