



Trump acts on immigration

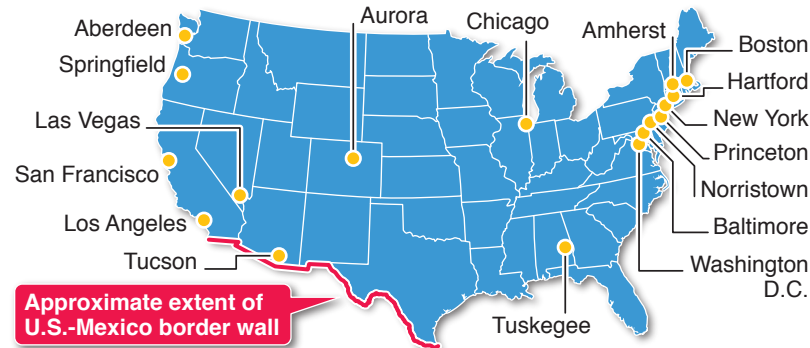
President Donald Trump is moving ahead with his immigration agenda, making good on plans for a border wall, targeting so-called “sanctuary cities” and reviewing proposals to restrict the flow of refugees to the United States

WALL

To be constructed by **Department of Homeland Security** along U.S.-Mexico border. Plan includes repair of existing fences and provision of 5,000 extra border staff. Some U.S. foreign aid to Mexico could be redirected to partially fund project

SANCTUARY CITIES

Funding – perhaps millions of dollars – could be cut if cities fail to hand over undocumented migrants to federal authorities

REFUGEES

Proposals being considered include temporary ban on most refugees, and suspension of visas for citizens of countries where U.S. considers security screening is inadequate.

Total refugee admissions for 2017 capped at 50,000. Syrian refugees barred from entering U.S. indefinitely. Pentagon and U.S. State Department to plan “safe zones” inside Syria
