

Williams sisters clash in Australian Open final

Venus and Serena Williams will contest their ninth Grand Slam final in Melbourne. A win for Serena will regain World No. 1 status and a record 23rd major title, while Venus' remarkable resurgence is rewarded with her first major final since Wimbledon in 2009
