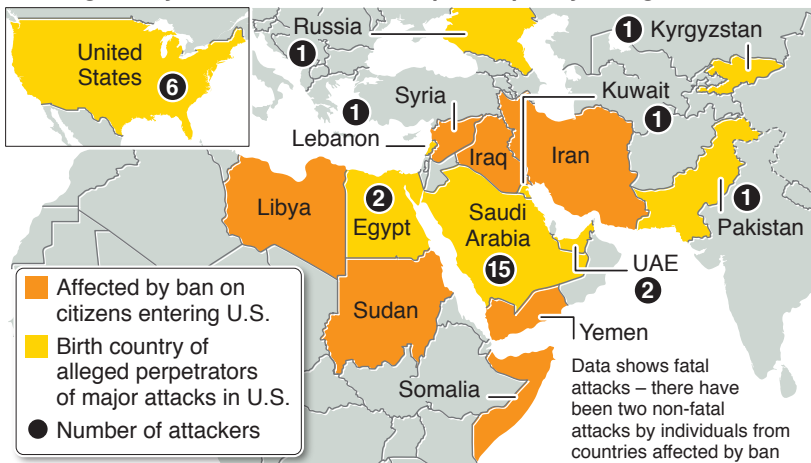


Jihadist terror attacks in U.S. since 9/11
