*March 19, 1932*

▲ **Australia's iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge officially opened. It is the world's tallest steel arch bridge, rising 134m (440ft) above water level at its highest point**

**1962:** Bob Dylan's debut album, Bob Dylan, was released by Columbia

**1972:** India and Bangladesh signed a treaty of friendship and mutual defence

**1982:** The Argentine flag was raised on the island of South Georgia, precipitating the Falklands conflict

**1997:** The World Health Organisation announced that a new treatment strategy for tuberculosis could save millions of lives over 10 years
