*March 29, 1891*

▲ **Georges Seurat, French post-impressionist painter who developed Pointillism, which uses small dots of colour to create an image, died at age 31**

**1827:** More than 10,000 mourners attended Ludwig van Beethoven's funeral in Vienna

**1867:** The Dominion of Canada, comprising Quebec, Ontario, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, was established

**1973:** The last remaining U.S. combat troops withdrew from Vietnam

**2004:** Ireland became the world's first country to impose a nationwide ban on smoking in public places
