

Deadly year for Western Europe



■ **UK – Mar 22, 2017:** Four people killed and 40 injured after attacker drives car into pedestrians and stabs police officer to death inside gates of Parliament. **Attacker – shot dead by police – is associated with Birmingham-based Islamic State-group linked to earlier Paris and Brussels attacks**

■ **France – Mar 18:** Man is shot dead at Orly airport near Paris after attempt to snatch gun from soldier

■ **France – Feb 3:** Egyptian national, Abdullah Reda al-Hamamy, is shot and seriously wounded during attack on soldiers in shopping mall at Louvre museum, Paris

■ **Germany – Dec 19, 2016:** Twelve people killed and 48 injured in truck attack at crowded Christmas market in Berlin

■ **France – Jul 26:** Two men who had pledged allegiance to IS are shot dead after killing Catholic priest as he performs mass in his church in Saint-Étienne-du-Rouvray

■ **Germany – Jul 24:** Fifteen people injured after IS-linked Syrian asylum seeker blows himself up outside wine bar in Ansbach

■ **Germany – Jul 22:** Ten people, including German-Iranian gunman, killed and 36 injured in attack at McDonald's restaurant in Munich

■ **France – Jul 14:** IS-inspired truck attack during Bastille Day celebrations in Nice kills 86 people and injures scores more

■ **France – Jul 14:** Police officer and his partner stabbed to death at their home outside Paris in presence of their three-year-old son



■ **Belgium – Mar 22:** Three IS suicide bombers blow themselves up at Brussels airport and in metro train station in Belgian capital, killing 32 people. Police link attacks to **Mohamed Abrini** (above), suspect in November 2015 attacks in Paris which leave 130 people dead and 368 wounded. **Abrini received money from Islamist group in Birmingham**
