The fourth season of the World Rallycross Championship gets underway in Barcelona, with Mattias Ekström the defending drivers' champion

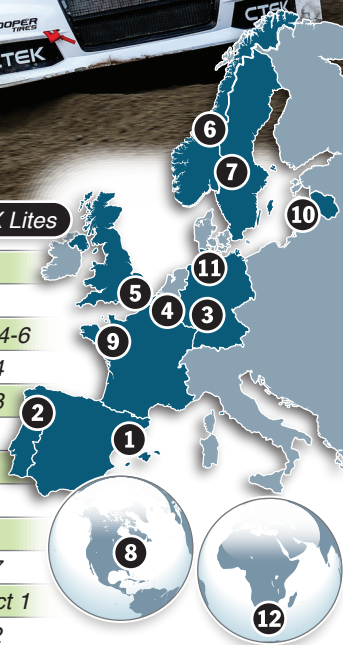

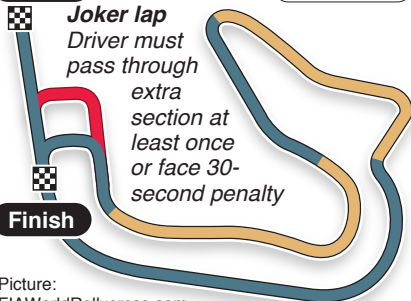

Heats: 50+ races.

Five cars per race – all race four times. 12 cars progress

Semi-finals:

Six cars per race – top three progress

Final: Six cars

Championship:

Points awarded at each stage. Driver with highest number of points over 12 rounds wins
