

Trump's bills and executive actions

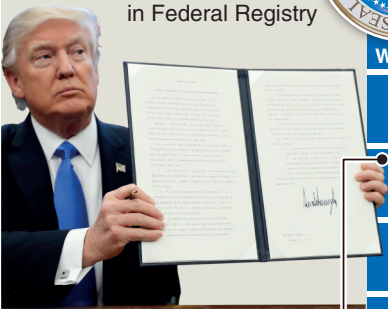
In his first 10 weeks in office, President Donald Trump has signed 45 orders, memoranda or proclamations and 17 bills or resolutions – the most prolific use of executive action to start a presidency

23 Executive orders:
New policy or directive, similar to laws passed by Congress.
Numbered and written in Federal Registry



19 Presidential memoranda: Instruction to federal agency – not recorded in Registry

13 Proclamations:
Ceremonial directives – e.g. U.S. Heart Month

Day 1 – Jan 20: President signs executive order declaring repeal of ***Affordable Care Act***

2

Day 4: Executive order to scrap President Obama's ***Trans-Pacific Partnership*** – trade deal with 11 countries

3

Day 5: Three memoranda approving oil pipelines

4

Day 6: Executive orders signed to build ***U.S.-Mexico border wall***

5

Day 15: Federal judge ***James Robart*** halts travel ban

6

Day 40: Trump signs bill nullifying Obama-era rule aimed at blocking gun sales to people who are mentally ill

7

Day 56 – Mar 16: Judges block revised travel ban hours before it is to go into effect

Day 65 – Mar 24: President suffers political setback when Republican leaders pull Trump's health-care bill to repeal and replace Obamacare

Day 69 – Mar 29: Federal judge ***Derrick Watson*** blocks Muslim travel ban indefinitely

Day 8 – Jan 27: Trump signs executive order banning refugees and immigrants from seven Muslim-majority countries. Travel ban triggers legal backlash

Day 27: Trump signs bill repealing environmental rule protecting waterways from coal mining waste

Day 46 – Mar 6: Revised executive order reinstates Muslim travel ban

Day 68: Executive order scraps ***Clean Power Plan*** which cut greenhouse gas emissions from power plants

Day 70: Trump signs executive orders to toughen anti-dumping laws one week before he meets Chinese President ***Xi Jinping*** in Florida
