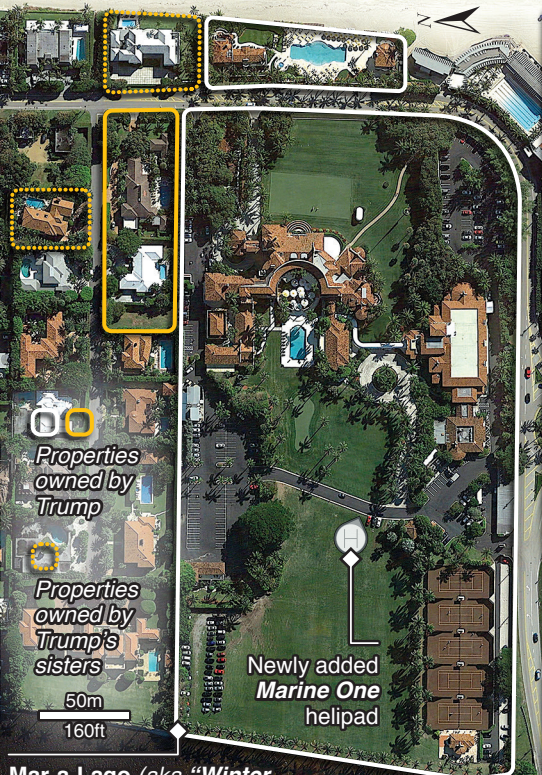


Trump's controversial Mar-a-Lago estate

U.S. President *Donald Trump* visits his private residence in Florida most weekends, often conducting business of a sensitive nature there. Democrats question the effectiveness of security and why U.S. tax payers should foot the alleged \$3 million bill for each visit



Mar-a-Lago (aka "Winter White House"): Estate built in 1927 by Postum Cereal heiress **Marjorie Merriweather Post**. Willed to government in 1973 for use as presidential retreat. Little used, it was returned to Post Foundation in 1980. Bought by Trump in 1985 for \$7m



SECURITY MEASURES FOR TRUMP VISITS

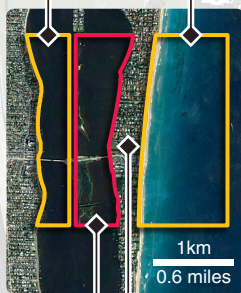
■ **Flight restrictions**
48km radius: No small aircraft allowed

16km:
Commercial/
emergency
flights only



1.5km: No aircraft

■ **Boat restrictions**
No stopping (except for draw bridge)



No boats allowed **Mar-a-Lago**
