

# Deadly terrorist attacks against Russia



■ **Apr 3, 2017:** Bomb blast on St Petersburg metro kills 14 people. **Kyrgyz-born Russian citizen Akbarzhon Jalilov (above)** named as prime suspect

■ **Oct 2015:** So-called Islamic State bombs Russian airliner over Egypt's Sinai Peninsula, killing all 224 people on board

■ **Dec 2013:** Two suicide bombings target rail station and bus in city of Volgograd, killing 34 people

■ **Jan 2011:** Bomb attack at Moscow's Domodedovo airport kills 37 people. Caucasus Emirate group led by Chechen warlord **Doku Umarov** claims responsibility



■ **Mar 2010:** Umarov's group claims responsibility for bomb blasts on Moscow metro which kill 40 people

■ **Nov 2009:** Bomb attack on high-speed railway linking St Petersburg and Moscow kills at least 26 people



■ **Sep 2004:** Over 300 hostages die, half of them children, when Russian forces storm Beslan school seized by heavily-armed militants demanding Chechen independence

■ **Aug 2004:** Two Tupolev airliners blown up almost simultaneously over southern Russia, killing 90 people

■ **Feb 2004:** Chechen separatists blamed for Moscow metro bombing which kills at least 39 people

■ **Oct 2002:** Chechen militants seize crowded Moscow theatre in hostage crisis which leaves 130 people dead – most of them poisoned by gas used to subdue Chechens during storming of building
