*May 16, 1989*

▲ Chinese leader Deng Xiaoping and Soviet President Mikhail Gorbachev held the first Sino-Soviet summit in 30 years, ending the feud between the two nations

**1967:** French President Charles de Gaulle imposed a virtual veto on Britain's application to join the EEC

**1995:** The Polish currency, the zloty, was floated on international currency markets

**1996:** Paleontologists announced the discovery in Morocco of a 1.5m (5ft) high dinosaur skull, from a carnivore bigger than Tyrannosaurus Rex

**2013:** Apple hit 50 billion downloads on its App Store
