

# Trump's first presidential foreign trip

U.S. President Donald Trump makes his first foreign trip from May 19-26, with visits to Saudi Arabia, Israel, the Vatican, Belgium and Sicily



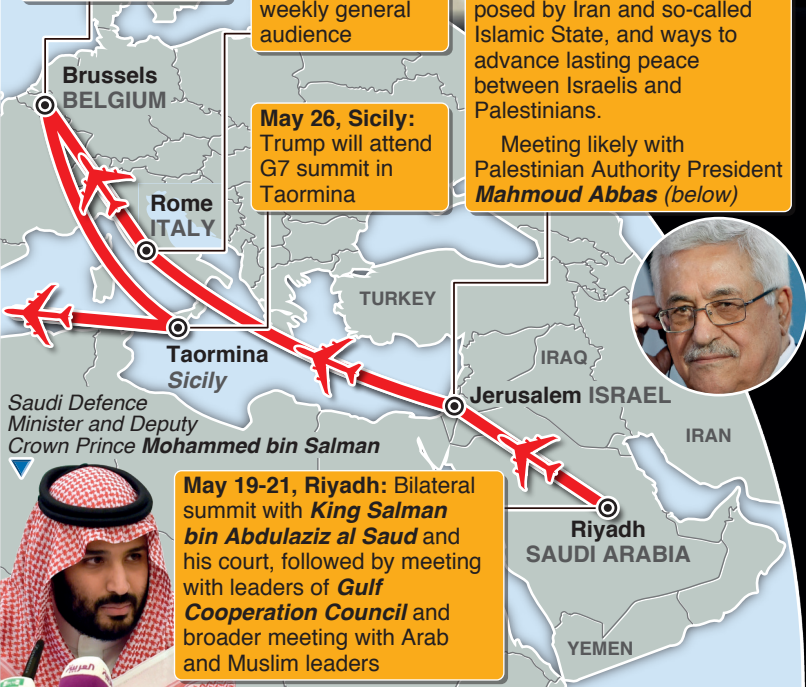
**May 25, Brussels:** Trump to attend NATO summit and opening of new headquarters

**May 24, Vatican:** *Pope Francis* will receive Trump in Apostolic Palace ahead of his weekly general audience

**May 22-23, Jerusalem:** Talks with Prime Minister **Benjamin Netanyahu** (above) and President **Reuven Rivlin** expected to cover threats posed by Iran and so-called Islamic State, and ways to advance lasting peace between Israelis and Palestinians.

Meeting likely with Palestinian Authority President **Mahmoud Abbas** (below)

**May 26, Sicily:** Trump will attend G7 summit in Taormina



Saudi Defence Minister and Deputy Crown Prince **Mohammed bin Salman**

**May 19-21, Riyadh:** Bilateral summit with **King Salman bin Abdulaziz al Saud** and his court, followed by meeting with leaders of **Gulf Cooperation Council** and broader meeting with Arab and Muslim leaders
