June 2, 1932

▲ **Major Frank Holmes, a New Zealand engineer, first struck oil in Bahrain. It marked the emergence of the petroleum industry in the Middle East**

1987: Spanish guitarist Andres Segovia, who established the guitar as a serious classical instrument, died

1992: Danish voters stunned the European Community by rejecting the Maastricht Treaty

2009: China blocked access to social media ahead of the 20th anniversary of the Tiananmen Square massacre

2012: Former Egyptian President Hosni Mubarak was jailed for his role in the killing of protesters in 2011
