▲ **A British Member of Parliament, Jo Cox, was shot and stabbed to death in her constituency by a white nationalist with links to far-right extremism**

1903: Henry Ford incorporated the Ford Motor Company in Detroit with just \$28,000 capital from 11 investors

1992: Presidents George Bush and Boris Yeltsin agreed to cut stocks of long-range nuclear warheads

2009: The four emerging “BRIC” powers, Brazil, Russia, India and China, held their first summit
