


A history of terrorism across European cities


The deadly vehicle and knife attack on London Bridge and in nearby Borough Market is only the latest in Europe in recent years


Spain's 2004 train bombings remain Europe's worst terrorist incident, after Lockerbie bombing*




 **May 22, 2017, Manchester:** Suicide bomber kills 22 people and injures dozens more during *Ariana Grande* concert


 **Apr 7, 2017, Stockholm:** Man driving hijacked beer truck strikes pedestrians at department store, killing 4 people


 **Mar 22, 2017, London:** SUV drives into pedestrians at Westminster Bridge, killing four people. Attacker then stabs police officer to death

 **Dec 19, 2016, Berlin:** Hijacked truck ploughs through Christmas market, killing 12


 **Jul 14, 2016, Nice:** Bastille Day truck attack targets revellers, killing 86


 **Mar 22, 2016, Brussels:** Suicide attacks at airport and subway kill 32 and injure hundreds


 **Nov 13, 2015, Paris:** Extremists attack *Eagles of Death Metal* concert in Bataclan theatre and other sites, killing 130 people

 **Feb 14-15, 2015, Copenhagen:** Gunman kills Danish filmmaker *Finn Noergaard* and synagogue guard, wounding five police officers


 **Jan 7-9, 2015, Paris:** Gun assault at offices of satirical magazine *Charlie Hebdo* and attack on kosher grocery store kills 17 people (magazine office previously firebombed in 2011)


 **May 24, 2014, Brussels:** Four people killed at Jewish Museum by armed intruder

 **Mar 11-19, 2012, Toulouse:** Gunman claiming links to Al Qaeda kills seven people including three Jewish schoolchildren

 **Jul 22, 2011, Oslo:** Anti-Muslim extremist detonates bomb then launches shooting massacre on nearby Utoya island youth camp, killing 77 people

 **Mar 2, 2011, Frankfurt:** Islamic extremist shoots dead two U.S. airmen and injures two others at Frankfurt airport

 **Jul 7, 2005, London:** Fifty-two commuters killed when four Al Qaeda-inspired suicide bombers detonate explosives on three tube trains and a bus

 **Mar 11, 2004, Madrid:** Bombs on four commuter trains in morning rush hour kill 191 people



* Dec 21, 1988: Pan Am Flight 103, bound for New York, blown up over Scottish town of Lockerbie killing all 259 on board and 11 people on ground
