

Big majority for Macron in French parliament

French President Emmanuel Macron is poised to rearrange his Cabinet after his new centrist party won a landslide in the country's parliamentary election, enabling the government to quickly start passing its first laws



Macron's *La République en Marche* (LREM) won 308 seats with 43 percent of vote. With its centrist *MoDem* allies, LREM has 350 seats, way more than 289 needed for majority
