

Worst road tanker disasters

1 Jun 25, 2017, Pakistan: Tanker carrying 25,000 litres of fuel from Karachi to Lahore crashes and explodes killing at least 153 people as they collect leaking fuel

Nov 2016, Mozambique: Road tanker carrying petrol explodes killing 93 people

Sep 2016, Afghanistan: Bus collides with fuel tanker in Zabul Province, killing 38 people

May 2016, Afghanistan: Two buses collide with fuel tanker in Ghazni province, killing 73

Sep 2015, South Sudan: At least 203 killed and 150 injured in inferno as crowd tries to collect fuel after traffic accident

Jan 2015, Pakistan: At least 62 killed in fire after coach collides with tanker near Karachi

Jul 2012, Nigeria: Road tanker overturns and explodes – death toll placed at 104

Jul 2010, D.R. Congo: Fuel tanker crashes and explodes. Fireball devastates town of Sange in South Kivu province, killing 292 people
