


# Apple testing iPhone 3D face scanner

With its upcoming iPhone 8, Apple is strongly rumoured to be ditching the home button, including its Touch ID fingerprint sensor, in favour of an improved security system that will scan a user's face

## ■ iPhone 8: Also known as *iPhone Edition*

**Stereoscopic front camera:** Twin lenses and **3D sensor** scan face to unlock phone in milliseconds, even from oblique angle

**Face unlock:** Camera analyses more nodes than fingerprint scan – more secure than current **Touch ID** system



**Edge-to-edge display:** HD Retina OLED screen – thinner than any previous iPhone display

Touch controls replace **home button**

**Stainless steel frame:** Supports glass body

**Rear glass panel:** Allows **inductive charging** via optional accessory

**Stereoscopic rear camera (in landscape orientation):** Two lenses provide advanced augmented reality capabilities, using **ARKit** in **iOS 11**, to allow for stable motion tracking

**Magnetic coil:** Inductive charging zone behind glass

■ Apple likely to release updated **iPhone 7s** and **iPhone 7s Plus** in September, and **iPhone 8** in October, due to production delays. *iPhone generates nearly two thirds of Apple's sales*
