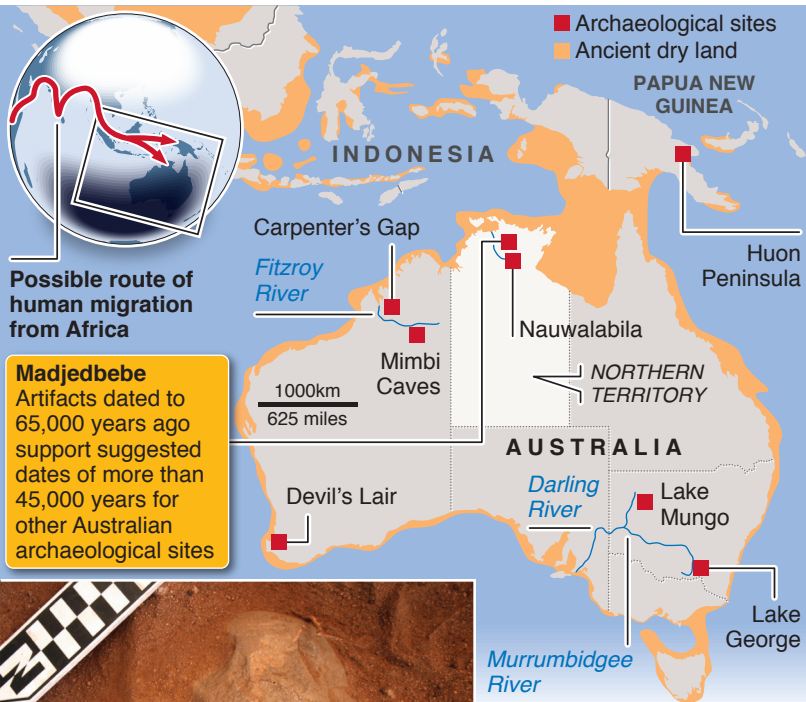


Rock find “rewrites” Australia human history

Excavations of a rock shelter in Australia’s Northern Territory suggest Aboriginal people reached the continent at least 65,000 years ago, up to 18,000 years earlier than archaeologists previously thought
