September 5, 1972

▲ **“Black September” terrorists attacked Israeli athletes at the Munich Olympics. The attack left 11 Israelis, five assailants and a German policeman dead**

1970: Jochen Rindt won the Formula One World Drivers' Championship posthumously, having been killed in practice at the Italian Grand Prix

1990: The prime ministers of North and South Korea began talks in Seoul

1995: France carried out the first of a series of underground nuclear tests

2002: President Hamid Karzai of Afghanistan narrowly escaped an assassination attempt in Kandahar
