▲ The Vittoria, captained by Juan Sebastian Del Cano since the death of Magellan, returned to Seville after completing the first circumnavigation of the world

1978: U.S. scientists announced the production of human-type insulin by a genetically engineered strain of E. coli

1994: It was confirmed that Anastasia, youngest daughter of Russia's last Tsar, Nicholas II, had died with her family in 1918

1997: Princess Diana's funeral was seen by 2.5bn TV viewers worldwide

2000: Fidel Castro shook hands for the first time with a sitting U.S. President, Bill Clinton
