Award follows \$500 billion deal between ExxonMobil and Russia's state-owned oil giant **Rosneft**

Dec: Kushner and Flynn meet **Kislyak** at Trump Tower

Sergey Gorkov



Dec 2016: Kushner meets with **Sergey Gorkov**, head of Russian state investment bank **VEB**

2016-17: **VEB's Evgeny Buryakov** is arrested and deported from U.S. for spying. **Buryakov** allegedly tried to recruit **Carter Page** – Trump campaign foreign policy advisor – as Russian spy

Dec 2015: Flynn is paid \$33,750 for participating in Moscow panel honouring Kremlin-backed TV network **RT**



Nov 2016: Flynn makes phone call to **Sergei Kislyak**, Russian Ambassador to U.S.

Dec: Flynn and **Jared Kushner** meet **Kislyak** at Trump Tower

Dec 29: Flynn places five phone calls to **Kislyak** on day **President Obama** announces sanctions on Russia

Feb 13: Flynn is fired after serving as **national security adviser** for just 24 days, following revelations that he discussed ending sanctions against Moscow with **Kislyak**

May: Senate Intelligence Committee demands that Flynn provide it with list of any contacts with Russian officials. Flynn invokes his Fifth Amendment right against self-incrimination
