

U.S. Navy recent mishaps



Aug 21, 2017: Ten U.S. sailors are missing and five are injured after guided-missile destroyer **USS John S. McCain** collides with oil tanker **Alnic MC**

Jun 17, 2017: Seven U.S. sailors are killed in collision between Arleigh Burke-class destroyer **USS Fitzgerald** (below) and Philippine-flagged container ship **ACX Crystal** near Japan. Commander and two officers relieved of their duties



USS John S. McCain: Damage to hull flooded crew berths, machinery and communications rooms

May 9: Guided-missile cruiser **USS Lake Champlain** collides with 70-foot fishing boat during training exercise off South Korea. No injuries reported

Jan 31: Guided missile cruiser **USS Antietam** runs aground after dragging its anchor in Tokyo Bay

Aug 19, 2016: Nuclear ballistic-missile submarine **USS Louisiana** and **USNS Eagleview** collide off coast of Washington State. No injuries reported

Nov 20, 2014: **USNS Amelia Earhart** and **USNS Walter S. Diehl** collide during exchange of goods in Gulf of Aden. No injuries

Aug 12, 2012: Arleigh Burke-class destroyer **USS Porter** collides with oil tanker **MV Otowasan** in Strait of Hormuz. No injuries

Mar 20, 2009: Nuclear attack submarine **USS Hartford** collides with amphibious transport **USS New Orleans** while at periscope depth in Strait of Hormuz – fifteen sailors aboard submarine injured
