*September 16, 1932*

▲ Mahatma Gandhi began a fast over Britain's decision to separate India's electoral system by caste. He believed this would perpetuate the divide between social classes

**1987:** The Montreal Protocol led to ozone depleters such as CFCs being phased out in aerosols and refrigerants

**1992:** George Soros made over \$1 billion when Britain withdrew from the European Exchange Rate Mechanism

**2000:** Peru's newly re-elected president Alberto Fujimori stepped down after becoming embroiled in a fraud scandal

**2007:** Former U.S. football star O.J. Simpson faced six charges over an alleged armed robbery in Las Vegas
