▲ Having conquered almost all of central Arabia, Abdul-Aziz ibn Saud united his dominions into the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, with himself as king

1952: Rocky Marciano won the world heavyweight boxing title when he knocked out Jersey Joe Walcott

1999: Doctors in New York announced they had carried out the first ovarian tissue transplant

2003: Scandinavia's worst power failure in 20 years shut down southern Sweden and eastern Denmark

2010: At the UN, Iran said the U.S. government carried out the 9/11 attacks to protect Israel
