Ten years on from the release of Apple's seminal iPhone, the American tech giant has unveiled its latest smartphone update — the *iPhone X*



iPhone X unveiled at new **Steve Jobs Theater**, in Apple's new 70 hectare **Apple Park** campus

Notch: Houses **TrueDepth Camera** (7MP) used for unlocking device with **Face ID**, which recognises user's face and can validate **Apple Pay** transactions



Elongated Side Button: Easier to reach with right thumb, it now offers other functions such as waking digital assistant **Siri**

Edge-to-edge Super Retina HD OLED display: 1125 x 2436 pixel resolution at 458 pixels per inch

Home Button removed: Replaced by upward swipe gesture combined with Face ID to unlock iPhone
