▲ **U.S. National Guardsmen led nine black students into an Arkansas school after state militia stopped them entering the racially segregated school**

1513: Spanish explorer Vasco Nunez de Balboa crossed the Panama isthmus and became the first European to set eyes on the Pacific Ocean

1932: Catalonia was briefly granted autonomy from Spain

2005: Parliamentary elections in Poland resulted in a sweeping victory for the centre-right

2016: Arnold Palmer, widely regarded as one of the world's greatest ever golfers, died aged 87
