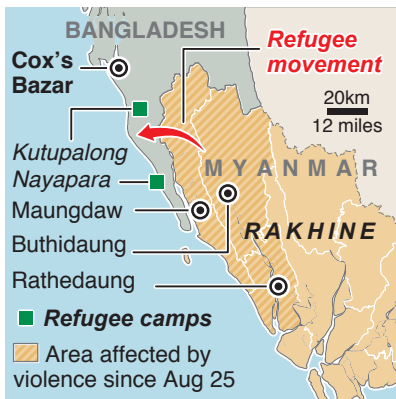


Rohingya refugee exodus grows

International pressure is mounting on Myanmar to end violence that has sent nearly 400,000 Rohingya Muslims fleeing to Bangladesh, which is calling for safe zones to enable refugees to go home
