October 3, 1942

▲ Germany's V2 rocket made its first successful test flight. It had a range of 200 miles and killed over 2,700 Londoners in the last months of World War II

1932: Iraq became independent and joined the League of Nations

1972: The Strategic Arms Limitation Treaty (SALT) was signed, limiting the United States and Soviet Union to 200 anti-ballistic missiles each

1990: East and West Germany were formally reunited after 45 years

2015: U.S.-led military airstrikes hit a Médecins Sans Frontières hospital in Kunduz, Afghanistan, killing at least 30 people
