

Fears of volcanic eruption on Bali

Up to 50,000 people have fled their homes near the largest volcano on the holiday island of Bali, as authorities warn it could soon erupt



Mount Agung: Authorities impose 12km exclusion zone and issue highest level alert following hundreds of tremors and signs of magma rising to surface

Indonesia, which sits on Pacific “Ring of Fire”, has 130 active volcanoes
1963: Over 1,000 people died in last eruption of Mount Agung
