▲ **Russian Bolsheviks led by Lenin overthrew the moderate socialist government of Alexander Kerensky in the first Marxist revolution in history**

1952: The United States blocked Communist China's entry to the United Nations for the third consecutive year

1955: The first domestic microwave oven went on sale, priced at \$1,295

2004: America's huge International Steel Group was taken over by Mittal Steel, led by India's Lakshmi Mittal

2015: Justin Trudeau's Liberal Party pulled off an upset in Canada's federal election, ending nine years of Conservative rule
