▲ **The Chicago Cubs beat the Cleveland Indians to win the 2016 baseball World Series, ending a 108-year title drought, the longest in World Series history**

**1917:** British foreign secretary Lord Balfour declared an intention to set up a Jewish homeland in Palestine

**1920:** KDKA in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, became the world's first regular broadcasting station

**1988:** A U.S. student released the first significant computer "worm", clogging thousands of computers

**2003:** Anglican Church leaders feared a schism after the first openly gay bishop was consecrated in the U.S.
