1924: China's last Manchu emperor, 18-year-old Pu-Yi, was expelled from the Forbidden City

1996: Iceland was flooded after a volcanic eruption beneath Europe's largest glacier melted tons of ice

2007: President Pervez Musharraf of Pakistan suspended the constitution on the grounds of growing Islamic militancy and hostile judges

2007: China's first lunar satellite, Chang'e 1, went into orbit
