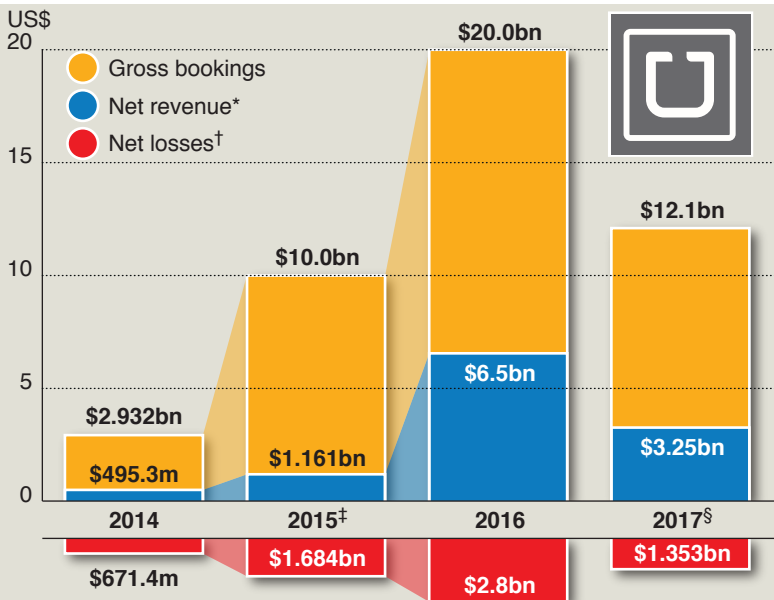


# Uber's woes and losses grow

Uber has suspended its unlicensed UberPOP service in Norway's capital, Oslo. Several European capitals have banned the service, while Uber recently lost its license to operate in London



**May 2014:** Authorities in **Barcelona** shut down Uber following regulatory problems

**Dec:** India's capital **New Delhi** temporarily bans Uber following accusations of rape against one of its drivers

**Jun 2015:** UberPOP banned in **Paris**, France

**Sep:** Uber quits U.S. state of **Alaska**, pays \$78,000 fine

**Oct:** **Bulgaria** Supreme Court shuts Uber – only licensed taxi services allowed

**Feb 2016:** Australia's **Northern Territory** bans Uber

**May:** Uber's U.S. service in **Austin, Texas** banned for 12 months

**Jul:** Uber service ruled illegal in **Hungary**

**Aug:** Uber sells its operation in **China**

**Feb 2017:** Uber suffers two-month suspension in **Taiwan**

**Apr:** **Italy** blocks Uber for one month. **Denmark** bans UberPop

**Jul:** **Finland** bans UberPop

**Sep:** UK capital **London** refuses Uber's request for new licence
