*November 18, 1477*

▲ A book called *The Dictes and Sayengis of the Phylosophers* was printed by William Caxton. It was the first dated book to be printed in the English language

**1307:** William Tell shot an apple off his son's head with a crossbow, an act that inspired a Swiss revolt against Austria

**1963:** The first push-button telephone went into service, eventually replacing the rotary dial
